- 8.1.4.(a) If a student inadvertently competes in more than three rounds, and it is clear from the team scoresheet which round should be omitted, the extra round shall not be counted.

Proposed:

Between 7.5 Freshman Meets and 7.6 Meet Procedures, add:

7.6 Calculators

- (a) Students may use calculators in any round except those where it is expressly prohibited.
- (b) Calculators with a QWERTY keyboard, such as the TI-92 or HP-95, or which contain a Computer Algebra System, such as the TI-89, HP 40G, 48GII, HP49G, or HP50G, are not allowed in WOCOMAL. Such calculators should not be brought to the meet.
- (c) If a student is discovered to have used a prohibited calculator at the meet, that student shall receive a zero in all rounds allowing calculator use.
